In Brief

During the Meeting, Council also:

- Approved a Minor Variance to allow a reduction to the MDS setback to a dwelling unit for 22853 Heritage Road
- Approved a Consent to Sever Land at 2227 Hamilton Road to split a farm located within two municipalities
- Approved a Consent to Sever Land at 4301 Putnam Road to create 4 new residential lots
- Approved a Consent to Sever Land at 5050 Avon Drive to dispose of a surplus farm dwelling
- Approved temporary zoning to allow a mobile home for a maximum of 10 years at 22538 Purple Hill Road
- Extended the Facility Use Agreement with the Boys and Girls Club of London until December 31, 2023, to provide programs to the youth of Thames Centre
- Received a Financial Report from the Director of Financial Services/Treasurer and directed the surplus be allocated to reserves
- Council did not support the Community Infrastructure and Housing Accelerator Order (CIHAO) requested by Farhi Holdings Corporation
- Received a report on the proposed new Provincial Policy Statement from the Director of Planning and Development Services and directed staff to forward the report to the Province as comments on the review of the proposed policies
- Council appointed Eric Boulard as Chief Building Official
- Approved the establishment of Human Resources Manager Position
