

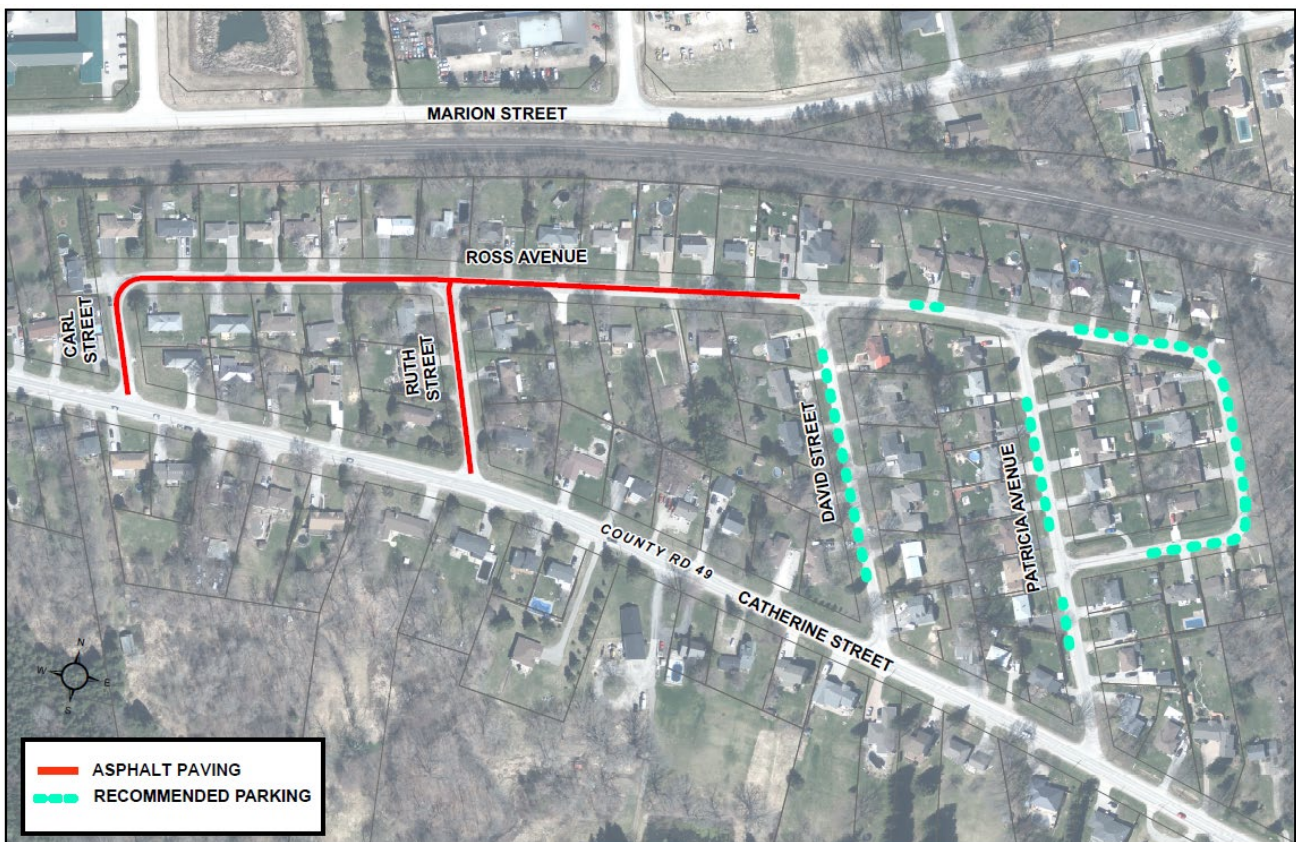

Dear Property Owner,

The Municipality of Thames Centre hereby notifies and advises all residents and affected parties of the anticipated scheduling of the topcoat of asphalt in Porters Subdivision Phase 2. 291 Construction has informed the Municipality that the paving contractors are expected to arrive on-site beginning at 7:00 AM on Wednesday July 10, 2024. The current weather forecast shows Wednesday is likely going to rain, which will result in the paving being pushed back to Thursday July 11, 2024. The paving process is anticipated to be completed in one day.

Impact on Residents

How to Prepare:

- Kindly relocate your vehicles to the designated parking areas by 7:00 AM to accommodate the paving process
- Inform any visitors or service providers about the paving schedule
- The paving process is expected to take approximately one day. Please avoid driving on the new asphalt for at least four hours after completion. If you must drive on it sooner, please avoid dry steering, as this can create ruts in the new surface
- If you have any special needs or concerns, please contact the Municipality at the number below

Road Access / Driveway Access and Parking

While roads will remain open during the paving process, we request that residents avoid driving on the fresh asphalt for a minimum of 4 hours, unless it is necessary. This will help ensure the best possible finish and longevity of the new surface.

Noise

Please be aware that there will be some noise associated with the construction activities. We apologize for any inconvenience this may cause and appreciate your understanding and patience as we work to complete these improvements efficiently.

Garbage & Recycling Collection
