It was decided that Bridge Fest would be on Saturday, September 11, 2021 from 2:00 - 8:00 p.m. K. Elliott verbally reported that the Thames Centre Special Events Committee can focus on trying to make this event more diverse by welcoming vendors and food trucks of all cultures. We could line booths up from the bridge, all the way to the FlightExec Centre. If we just want to utilize the bridge, we could fit 15 vendors, with 8x8 tents. In addition, we will set-up the event trailer for entertainment on the end of the walking bridge and people will be encouraged to walk down to local establishments to visit their patios. On Saturday, September 11, 2021 the Dorchester Lions Club would be interested in doing fireworks to finish off the event, which will commence at dark. With all these ideas, K. Elliott brings up a great point how these ideas may bring large crowds.
