The Thames Centre Playground program is open to children who have completed Junior Kindergarten up to grade seven with two locations: Dorchester & Thorndale.

### FlightExec Centre Expansion Project Update

Excitement continues to grow regarding the expansion project budgeted for the FlightExec Centre this year. The Council has authorized staff to negotiate with MCI Design-Build to finalize the expansion & improvements for the Senior Centre, the auditorium, and the space rented by the Victoria Order of Nurses (VON). The Expansion Committee hopes to have a recommendation presented to Council at the April 12th Council meeting, which, if approved, would lead to construction beginning shortly thereafter.

# Marriage Licences



Congratulations on your upcoming nuptials!

#### What You need To Know:

- A marriage licence is required to get married in Ontario.
- The licence is valid for use in Ontario only.
- The licence expires 3 months after the date of issuance.
- The cost for a marriage licence is \$140.00. Payment can be made by cash or debit.
- Your application can be submitted through mail, email, dropping it off inperson at the office or using our drop box outside of office hours
- Once your application has been reviewed, a staff member will reach out to you to schedule an appointment to pick up your licence
- APPOINTMENTS ARE REQUIRED

#### **Booking an Appointment**

- Appointments will be scheduled within 3-5 business days of completing the application.
- With an appointment, if you have the required identification and supporting documentation, it will take approximately 20-30 minutes to process your application and issue the licence.

## **Important Water Supply Notice**

The Thames Centre Water Department will be conducting their Spring Flush Program during the week of April 17th - 21st, 2023, between the hours of 8:00am - 4:00pm.

Fire hydrant flushing is done to remove any sediment or stagnant water from the distribution system and to test fire hydrant operation. These steps are taken to improve overall water quality within the distribution system.

## Porter Subdivision Update

The Municipality of Thames Centre implemented a Watermain Replacement and Road Reconstruction of Porters Subdivision – Phase 1 in 2022.

The 2022 Phase I reconstruction area included David Street, Patricia Ave, and Ross Ave from David Street East.



The reconstruction work included complete reconstruction of the roads, implementation of curbs and sidewalks, replacement of the watermain, and storm sewer replacement. Phase 1 will be completed in the Spring of 2023.

Phase 2 will begin in the Spring of 2023. The 2023 Phase 2 reconstruction area includes Carl Street, Ruth Street, and Ross Ave from David Street West. The reconstruction work includes complete reconstruction of the roads, implementation of curbs and sidewalks, replacement of the watermain, and upgraded storm sewers.

## Hamilton Road Sanitary Trunk Sewer Project

Beginning in the SPRING of 2023, the installation of new sanitary sewer and services to the property line of each residence for connection will begin to take place.
