Purpose and Effect of Consent Application

The purpose and effect of this application is to establish an access easement in favour of 4186 Crampton Drive over a portion of the subject lands to continue to allow access to 4186 Crampton Drive via the existing driveway.

Description and Location of Subject Land

The subject lands are legally described as Part of Lot 4, Concession 3; and Part 3 of 33R161 (geographic Township of North Dorchester), Municipality of Thames Centre. The subject property is located on the northwest corner of Crampton Drive and Putnam Road (County Road 30) in the Hamlet of Putnam.


