Motion Passed - Thorndale Lions Club Expansion

At last night's meeting, a motion was passed to explore the expansion of the Thorndale Lions Club.

The motion was put forward by Councillor Tom Heeman, and it called for the creation of "an Ad-Hoc Committee for the expansion of the Thorndale Community Centre, with the goals of consulting on a design of a future expansion."



The proposed expansion would include a new hall with a stage, an expanded kitchen area, and paved parking areas.

The motion called for Council to receive a report from the committee in January 2025.
