Boys and Girls Club Receives 2025 Community Grant

\$5,000 Grant Supports Youth Programs in Dorchester and Thorndale

THAMES CENTRE – Today the Boys and Girls Club of London (BGC London) received \$5,000 in funding from Thames Centre's Community Partnership Grant program.
